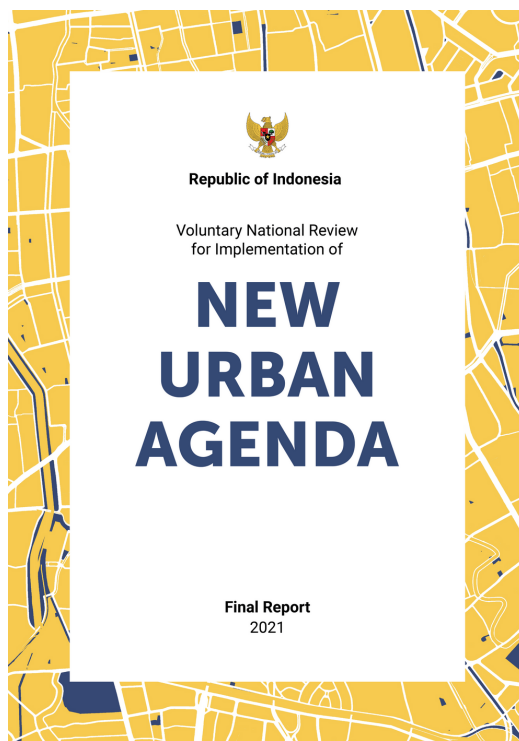

Gender Development Index increased from 90.99% (2018) to 91.06% (2020)



Urban slum households reduced from 13.04% (2018) to 10.04% (2020)

Internet users increased from 64.8% (2019) to 84.7% (2021)*



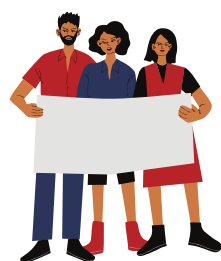
Households with access to safe drinking water increased from 84.95% (2015) to 89.27% (2019)

70% provinces and 34% cities/regions have Disaster Risk Reduction documents (2019)



Households with access to basic sanitation increased from 71.78% (2016) to 79.53% (2020)

99.99% of companies are MSMEs with GDP contribution increased from 57.2% (2016) to 61.07% (2021)* *



Total achievements of the One Million Houses Program are 5,765,387 units (2015-2020) and increased 1,105,707 units (2021)***

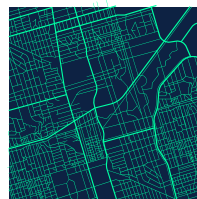

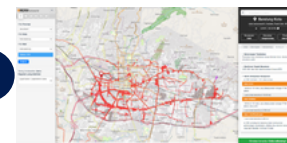

Online Single Submission (OSS) and One Stop Service (PTSP) to facilitate licensing



The Spatial Geospatial Information System (GISTARU) has prepared online and interactive spatial plans for 63 cities/districts since 2019

Real-time online-based monitoring and forecasting system; and early warning for hydrological disasters, earthquakes, tsunamis, forest fires, volcanoes, landslides

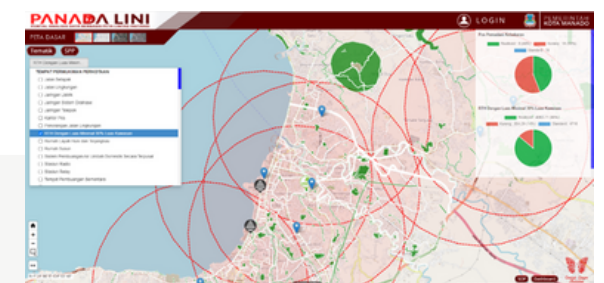
SUROBOYO BUS

Implementation of the Suroboyo Bus since 2018, with a payment system using plastic bottle waste, is a form of collaboration with the Surabaya Main Waste Bank, Bintang Mangrove and Pitoe
